Saleyard feeder rates mostly eased 1-6¢/kg lwt week-on-week, with the rain down the Queensland coast coming too late and not penetrating inland enough to have any significant impact on the physical market. Out of the paddock prices lifted slightly week-on-week, with domestic heifers the exception.
