## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Yarding numbers declined 65% after some good rainfall across some of the usual supply areas over the weekend. The quality of cattle penned varied from plain to good quality steers and heifers. Fewer restockers were present at the sale, but those in attendance displayed solid demand for good light weight yearling steers and heifers. All the usual commission feedlot buyers were active and prices remained similar to the previous week for medium and heavy yearling steers, while good quality medium weight heifers jumped 9c/kg. The major export processors showed increased demand for the small yarding of cows. Cows and calves topped at \$1000 and averaged \$761/unit.

Light weight yearling steers sold to 280c for light weight sorts, while slightly heavier consignments made to 272c and most averaged between 243c and 245c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed hit 260c and averaged 234c, while those returning to the paddock hit 274c and averaged 258c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed earned to 260c and averaged 250c, up 2c/kg.

Light weight yearling heifers to restockers made to 208c and averaged 199c, up 6c, while those to processors topped at 200c and averaged 196c, up 8c/kg. Those to feedlot buyers reached 210c and averaged 194c, up 3c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed hit 220c and averaged 191c, up 9c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows made to 182c and averaged 176c, up 6c, while heavy weight 4 score cows earned to 194c and averaged 190c, up 2c/kg.
