

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Store cattle numbers increase again this week. The quality of cattle improved for steers and heifers, while larger numbers of plainer cows were penned from central and north west Queensland. More feedlot buyers were in attendance and prices increased 9c to 12c with the extra demand. Most classes of yearling heifers lifted in price, but restockers were less active than the previous sale. Cows and calves sold to \$990/unit.

Light weight yearling steers sold to 290c and averaged 263c, unchanged in price, while slightly heavier weaner steers reached 285c and averaged 266c, up 13c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed reached 284c and averaged 267c, up 16c, while those to restockers made to 266c and averaged 261c, up 9c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed earned to 284c and averaged 274c, up 12c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to feedlot buyers topped at 244c and averaged 222c, up 5c, while those to processors hit 220c and averaged 201c and those returning to the paddock sold to 242c and averaged 218c, down 8c/kg. The 280-330kg yearling heifers to feedlot buyers sold to 248c and averaged between 207c and 234c, those to processors topped at 223c and averaged 206c while those to restockers made to 236c and averaged 216c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed hit 245c and averaged 229c, up 15c, while those to restockers sold to 245c and averaged 222c, down 25c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed earned to 230c and averaged 223c, up 23c/kg.

The plainer 2 score cows sold to 163c and averaged between 127c and 153c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows made to 194c and averaged 176c, while those returning to the paddock topped at 179c and averaged 159c/kg. Good heavy 4 score cows hit 205c and averaged 201c/kg.
