Feeder prices lifted again week-on-week, driven by strong buyer demand out of NSW. Heifers led the increase in out of the paddock quotes, gaining 11¢ on the previous week, while other lines mostly increased 8¢/kg. In the physical market, the lighter end of the feeder cattle saw the strongest gains, as restockers entered the market in increased numbers.
