Numbers jumped by more than 50%. Good quality light steers continued to attract solid restocker buyer demand, while heavier steers were mixed in quality and feedlot buyers appeared more selective. Yearling heifers were cheaper across all categories as feedlot buyer demand slowed and restockers were unwilling to pay the same prices as last week. With the processor buyers returning to the market cows reached 258c/kg.

Very light weight steers hit 404c and averaged 392c, while heifer calves topped at 334c and averaged 326c/kg. Light weight yearling steers sold to 404c and averaged 364c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feedlot buyers made to 348c and averaged 327c, down 13c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers earned to 330c and most averaged 325c, down 6c/kg.

Light weight yearling heifers returned to the paddock at up to 328c and averaged 310c, down 15c, while those to feedlot buyers reached 320c and averaged 302c, down 32c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed topped at 328c and averaged 304c, down 42c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows averaged 237c/kg. Brahman-cross cows with 1 to 2 month old Charbray calves at food sold to \$1,700 and others averaged \$1,464/unit.
