The eastern states feeder indicators mostly improved week-on-week, with most categories increasing 2-5¢/kg lwt. Medium and long fed feeder export paddock prices were the exception, with most contributors keeping rates unchanged. The medium weight saleyard grown steer category recorded the strongest gains however it was lightly reported.
