Mixed trends were evident in paddock feeder sales this week, with export steer lines dearer while heifers and domestic steers were slightly cheaper.

Saleyard prices were mostly cheaper for all but yearling steers which remained steady week-on-week for lighter categories while heavier weights lifted 5c/kg.
