


## Weekly Slaughter Report

# Eastern states


### report generated on Monday 20 Mar 2017 for the week ending 17 Mar 2017

MLA's eastern states slaughter report captures cattle, lamb, sheep, goat and pig slaughter across each state (excluding Western Australia) on a weekly basis. Data is collected by MLA from a weekly survey covering approximately 95% of cattle slaughter, 92% of lamb slaughter, 90% of sheep slaughter, 80% of goat slaughter and 95% of pig slaughter.




