



LIVESTOCK SUPERVISOR POSITION

The Livestock Supervisor is directly responsible for co-coordinating operations at the abattoir, it is therefore critical that you have a clear understanding of the operational requirements to manage total site livestock and associated functions, so as to ensure proper scheduling, co-ordination and recording of livestock is occurring in accordance with regulatory and production requirements

Duties required within the position include:

- To manage transport, animal welfare, and stock maintenance (including feeding, holding periods, yarding conditions),
- To manage stock receipt and recording (including stock counts, identification and NVD's),
- To manage stockyard and paddock maintenance and environmental aspects
- To arrange stock preparation, including scheduling, drafting, penning and washing and reconciliation of stock weights.
- To manage all livestock related staff inclusive of manning and ensuring all employees, contractors and/or stock delivery drivers adhere to regulatory and company requirements
- To monitor all costings and prepare associated reports in a timely manner

To be the successful applicant for this position the desired criteria includes a strong understanding of livestock and regulatory requirements and strong communication skills. Previous managerial experience would also be highly considered.
