The number of cattle yarded was well up, with young cattle making up a large percentage of the yarding and grown cattle also in good numbers. The yarding of young cattle consisted mainly of vealers and a fair penning of medium and heavy yearlings. Quality of the young cattle was mixed with some well finished yearlings and vealers through the sale, however, there was a fair number of plainer grades offered. A large percentage of vealer steers and heifers went to restockers at stronger rates, while vealer heifers to slaughter were slightly easier. Most of the yearling steers were acquired by feeders and sold slightly easier. The yarding of export cattle consisted of a good penning of cows, while bullocks and steers were in fair numbers. There were several pens of medium and heavy high yielding cow offered, while there was a mixed supply of grown steers. Grown steers sold firm to 2c/kg cheaper, while the cow market saw little change.
