The very small yarding was again dominated by young store grades with all grades of slaughter cattle in very short supply. The low numbers of recent times have prompted agents to go to a fortnightly format at this market with no sale scheduled for next week.

The low numbers of slaughter grades encouraged a solid trade demand that saw the heavy weight prime cow market rebound from the losses of the previous week.

Store demand was solid but at time erratic with a quieter feeder demand seen and a strong restocker competition recorded.
