Numbers eased slightly and quality was fair with most of the yarding comprising of heavy beef cow in various fat score categories. The regular contingent of buyers attended along with a major processor who didn't operate fully.

Heavy cows sold to strong southern demand resulting in values lifting 4c, while the D3 medium weight pens were 6c dearer averaging 142.7c/kg. Heavy 4 score cows made from 146c to 159.2c/kg. Dairy cows sold to spirited bidding as prices strengthened 1c reaching a top price of 136c/kg.

There was a mixed selection of younger bulls offered and good quality B muscled categories sold to a dearer trend of 1c prices ranged from 160c to 176c/kg.
