Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

All classes of cattle were well represented. Young cattle were in fair numbers; however bullocks and steers were the highlight of the sale, with a consignment from the North West that met keen competition from processors. Cows and heifers were in limited supply.

Quality of the young cattle was mixed with an odd pen of vealers and yearlings suitable for the trade, although a large percentage of steers and heifers went to restock and feeders with some well bred cattle attracting keen demand. Well bred restocker weaner steers sold to 243.2c, while vealer heifers to slaughter sold to 215.2c/kg. Yearling steers to the trade sold to 224.2c, while light feeder steers toped at 223.2c/kg. Yearling heifers were in smaller numbers and sold according to quality.

The yarding of export cattle was made up mainly of bullocks and steers, with a small penning of cows and heifers. Heavy bullocks toped at 180.2c and averaged 174c, while heavy steers sold to 181.2 to average around 172c/kg. There was only an odd pen of heavy cows and they sold to a top of 155c/kg.
