The yarding was up slightly, consisting of a good supply of young cattle and a fair number of grown cattle. There was increased numbers of heavy and light yearlings offered with the majority off crop and supplementary fed, along with several pens of well bred cattle suitable for feeder buyers.

Competition was strong with restocker vealers selling to a dearer tend, light vealer steers topped at 279.2c and medium weights sold to 253.6c/kg. Vealer heifers also sold to a dearer market. Vealer heifers to slaughter were up by 6c and sold to 230c/kg. Trade yearling steers were in larger numbers and sold at recent strong prices, while yearling heifers followed a similar trend and feeder cattle were also keenly sought after.

The yarding of export cattle was made up of several pens of well finished steers and bullocks, many off crop and supplementary fed, while there was a mixed yarding of cows. Steers and bullocks were 5c to 7c/kg dearer, while the cow market was firm to slightly dearer.
