A slightly larger good quality yarding of 775 beef cows together with lines of plain quality pastoral breeds and also 35 bulls sold. There was steady South East and Victorian processor competition, with local restocker orders sourcing small lines of plain quality beef cows.

The D2 to C6 medium and heavy beef cows sold from 115c to 158c at prices generally 2c to 6c/kg dearer. The D6 sales were 15c/kg cheaper as most cows sold in a 255c to 305c/kg cwt price range. The poorer quality pastoral breeds sold from 40c to 90c, while the rest sold from 100c to 147c to be unchanged to 14c/kg cheaper. Restockers purchased limited numbers with prices from 128c to 145c to be 13c/kg lower.

Bull prices were hard to follow with most sold below 158c/kg in the early runs before lifting again by the finish. This left most selling from 140c to 176c, or from 1c dearer to 13c/kg cheaper.
