## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

## Toowoomba Landmark report date 05 Dec 2011 Yarding -500 comparison date 28/11/2011

The number of cattle yarded was similar to previous weeks with grown cattle making up the largest percentage of the yarding, while young cattle were in fair numbers. Quality of the young cattle was mixed with most going to feeders and restockers and a few pens of well finished yearlings going to the trade.

Competition was very keen for both restockers and trade yearlings. Trade yearling steers sold to 229c, while heifers toped at 218c/kg. Restocker yearling steers ranged from 212c to 245.2c/kg.

The yarding of export cattle consisted of several pens of bullocks and steers, however cows were well supplied. Quality was mixed in a very strong market, with bullocks and steer selling to 209.2c and heifers selling to 194c/kg. The cow market gained some ground with heavy weights ranging from 170c to 179.2c/kg.
