Numbers jumped due to majority of cattle being trucked to the sale before 45mm of rain fell across the local area. Most consignments were from the local supply area and south west parts of the State, with a large consignment of cows from the Northern Territory. The restocker buyers could feel the wet rain soaking through their hats and provided plenty of spirited bidding for young, light weight yearling steers which gained 3c/kg. The extra competition also forced the hand of southern processor buyers to pay more for suitable vealer steers and vealer heifers. Young, light heifers were in good supply and feeder and restocker buyers battled to secure good lines. As a result, light weight yearling heifers to feedlots for backgrounding held firm in price while those to restocker buyers hit 232c/kg. Domestic feeder weight heifers jumped 17c, but plainer lines struggled to find the same demand and prices dropped 7c/kg. Cows mainly held firm in value compare to the previous store sale.

Vealer steers sold between 226c and averaged 232c, while medium weight vealer heifers reached 234c and averaged 226c, up 8c/kg. Light weight yearling steers to restockers hit 258c and averaged 231c, up 3c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed earned to 237c and averaged 211c, down 9c/kg, while those returning to the paddock made to 238c and averaged 227c, down 2c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed reached 219c and averaged 211c, up 12c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to feedlots sold to 234c and averaged 219c, unchanged in price, while those to restockers hit 232c and averaged 219c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed earned 206c and averaged 201c, up 17c/kg, while those to restockers made to 198c and averaged 192c/kg. Plainer lines of medium weight yearling heifers to feed averaged 179c, down 5c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed topped at 209c and averaged 203c, while those returning to the paddock earned to 201c and averaged 198c/kg.

Grown heavy steers to processors sold between 196c and 199c/kg. Grown heifers averaged 179c/kg. Lighter weight cows returned to the paddock at a high of 145c and averaged 142c/kg. Medium weight 4 score cows hit 179c and averaged 173c/kg, unchanged in value. Cows and calves sold to \$1120 and averaged \$866/unit.
