A slight decrease of numbers was offered to a smaller group of regular buyers as not all major processors operated. Quality was mixed with all weights and grades represented and demand was solid as processors were keen to purchase well finished high yielding cows.

Heavy well finished cows sold up to 5c dearer with sales strengthening as the market progressed. Well finished cows ranged in price from 145c to 162c/kg. Two and three score cows sold firm to 3c/kg dearer. The mixed quality selection of bulls sold to steady demand prices ranging from 162c to 176.6c/kg
