Agents yarded an increased number this sale. Quality was similar to that of the previous sale with both well finished and plainer cattle available. Yearlings made up the majority of the offering along with a handy penning of cows. The usual buyers were present and competing.

Vealer steers and heifers sold from 210c to 226c/kg. Yearling steers to processors lifted 6c to 10c, with the medium weights selling from 204c to 238c and heavies received 188c to 207c/kg. The medium weights to feeders were 3c dearer, the lightweights ranged from 190c to 251c/kg. The heavy weights were 6c dearer to receive 180c to 209c/kg. Thee heifer portion slipped 8c to 10c/kg mostly related to quality. Feeders paid from 172c to 215c while those processors receive 180c to 229c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks were fairly firm selling from 165c to 188c/kg. Grown heifers received 164c to 174c/kg. Cows eased 1c to 2c with heavy 2 score averaging 142c/kg. The better 3 score cows sold from 142c to 153c/kg.
