Following on from the cheaper trend of last week, a number of contributors have again lowered their prices. There were also a number of contributors that left their prices unchanged and are taking a wait and see approach. Demand for grain fed product is still stagnant which is not enticing feeders to increase their competition. The drier and cooler weather may force some extra numbers on to the market.

There was a dramatic reduction to throughput at physical markets last week in the lead up to the long weekend. This assisted some categories purchased by feeders. However a cheaper trend was evident again for some categories.
