Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Numbers rose slightly for a mixed quality yarding of prime cattle. Good bullocks continued to make 174c/kg, but plainer lines of bullocks and more subdued processor demand resulted in averages declining 4c to 5c/kg. Meanwhile, an improved quality yarding of grown heifers pushed prices averages up by 4c to 7c/kg with all the usual export processor buyers present and operating. Medium and heavy weight cows struggled to maintain the previous sale prices, while heavy bulls eased 9c/kg.

Plainer lines of heavy weight yearling heifers sold to 160c and averaged 153c, down 10c/kg. Medium weight grown steers topped at 171c and averaged 169c, down 5c/kg. The bullocks hit 174c and averaged 170c, down 4c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers sold to 162c and averaged 157c, up 4c/kg. The heavy grown heifers made to 165c and averaged 155c, up 7c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows earned to 130c and averaged 125c, down 5c/kg. The medium weight 4 score cows sold to 138c and averaged 136c, down 7c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows topped at 133c and averaged 130c, up 1c/kg. The heavy weight 4 score cows made to 146c and averaged 140c, down 5c/kg. Heavy bulls averaged 153c/kg, down 9c/kg.
