Prices have been mixed with fluctuations of 5¢/kg common across all categories. The gains from northern contributors were due to feeders looking to secure increased supply following recent rain. The greatest variations were from southern contributors as predominately tail end drafts are offered.

As physical market supply was reduced last week feeder categories were generally 1c to 4c/kg dearer.
