

## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Numbers remained similar to the previous sale. The majority of the cattle were drawn from the south-west Queensland supply area. The same numbers of export buyers were present, but a few were more selective when purchasing than the last prime sale. A mixed quality offering of grown steers resulted in prices easing 5c, while bullocks were firm in price to 1c/kg cheaper on average. Grown heifers could not maintain the previous sale prices with reductions of up to 9c/kg. The prime cow market bucked the trend and improved in price.

Heavy weight yearling steers to the trade sold to 179c and averaged 178c/kg. Medium weight grown steers topped at 176c and averaged 175c, down 5c, while bullocks hit 182c and averaged 176c, down 1c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers made to 168c and averaged 151c, down 8c, while heavy weight grown heifers earned to 168c and averaged 153c, down 9c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows sold to 135c and averaged 130c, up 6c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows made to 136c and averaged 134c, up 2c, while heavy weight 4 score cows sold to 152c and averaged 145c/kg to be unchanged in price. Heavy bulls averaged 153c, down 1c/kg.
