Numbers increased slightly in mixed quality offering with all weights and grades represented. An almost full field of buyers was in attendance with both major export companies keen to secure heavy well finished cows.

Heavy cows sold to strong demand with prices 12c/kg dearer. Well finished cows ranged from 138c to 154.6c/kg. Two and three score cows were in short supply and quality was plainer, the D3 medium weight lines averaged 142.5c and sold to a top price of 149.8c/kg.

The mixed quality selection of bulls sold to spirited competition and they made from 150c to 177.2c/kg.
