The solid rain last week, particularly in northern areas, is expected to impact on supply. Most contributors are taking a wait and see approach, and have left their rates unchanged. Only one contributor lifted 5c to 10c/kg cwt across the board. The winter conditions combined with the wet weather, is having an effect on the quality of some cattle. Demand for product is still weak although it is hoped that the end to school holidays could assist domestic enquiry.
