Numbers remained firm with most classes of cattle represented. Young cattle dominated the yarding with cows making up the largest percentage of the grown cattle. The yarding of young cattle consisted of a good supply of both vealers and yearlings with several pens of yearlings supplementary and crop fed however there was a fair percentage of vealer steers and heifers in plain condition.

Competition remained strong with vealer heifers to slaughter selling firm to slightly dearer toping at 212c, while restocker vealer steers topped at 226c/kg. Supplementary fed yearling steers sold on a strong market, although not to the high prices as last week toping at 219c/kg. The heifer portion settled on 221.2c/kg. Feeder and restocker cattle sold at similar prices.

The few pens of bullocks sold slightly easier with heavy C4's averaging 183c/kg. The yarding of cows was sourced from the South West that met keen competition. Overall the cow market saw heavy weights selling firm to slightly easier to average 146c while medium weight D3 cows held firm on 142c/kg.
