There was little change in the number of cattle yarded. The yarding consisted of a good supply of vealers and yearlings, and a fair penning of grown steers and cows. The yarding of young cattle consisted of an increased supply of yearlings and vealers while there was a few more light calves penned. Quality was mixed, although there was a larger number of supplementary fed yearlings and vealers and several pens of well-bred vealer steers.

Competition was strong with vealer heifers to slaughter selling 4c dearer ranging from 194c to 216.2c/kg. Restocker vealer steers sold to a dearer trend with the better bred light steers topping at 235.2c/kg. Supplementary fed yearling steers and heifers met stronger butcher and wholesale competition with the steers ranging from 191c to 233c while the heifers sold from 215c to 228c/kg.

The yarding of export cattle consisted of a fair supply of cows, bullocks and steers with several pens of steers crop finished, however the yarding of cows was fairly mixed. Bullocks and steers sold firm to a cheaper trend, while heavy cows saw little change and medium weights were 2c/kg cheaper and more in places.
