Numbers lifted this sale and quality was similar to the previous sales. There were a large percentage of plainer cattle on offer along with the well finished lines. Plainer secondary cattle showed a marked price reduction with the better cattle almost holding firm. Yearlings made up the majority of the yarding. The usual buyers were present and competing in a cheaper market.

Yearling steers to feed eased 5c to 6c/kg. Middleweights sold from 170c to 195c and heavies received from 170c to 198c/kg. Those to slaughter were 8c cheaper to receive from 172c to 230c/kg for middle and heavyweights. The heifer portion was 5c to 6c/kg easier. Processors paid from 162c to 214c for medium and heavyweights. Those to feeders ranged from 150c to 170c/kg.

Heavy steers and bullocks sold from 165c to 185c/kg. Grown heifers received 158c to 167c/kg. There was mostly heavy cows penned with 2 scores selling from 128c to 140c and 3 score receiving 138c to 150c/kg.
