## **Eastern States**

The majority of contributors left prices unchanged, although a few did reduce 5¢/kg for trade steers and heifers as numbers remain sufficient. Only slight price reductions were recoded for short fed cattle. Supply is currently satisfying demand with quality requirements being the underlying contributor to price changes.

In the physical market prices were generally dearer across all categories.
