## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Numbers returned to normal with cattle drawn from a wide area across the south-west region. Not all the usual export processor buyers were present, but prices remained firm for bullocks and cows gained 3c to 4c/kg. On the other hand, heavy bulls faced a downward price movement and dropped 6c/kg on average. Good quality lines of grown heifers helped price averages lift 1c/kg.

Medium weight yearling heifers topped at 165c and averaged 150c, down 18c/kg. Medium weight grown steers reached 185c and averaged 178c, up 2c/kg. Bullocks also sold to 185c and averaged 180c, unchanged in price. Grown heifers earned to 167c and averaged 159c, up 1c/kg.

Medium weight 3 score cows made to 139c and averaged 136c, up 3c, while medium weight 4 score cows reached 160c and averaged 152c, lifting 4c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows sold to 154c and averaged 150c, up 4c/kg. Heavy weight bulls averaged 156c, down 6c/kg.
