There were approximately 380 cows and 20 bulls penned. The usual buying group was present for a mixed market. Quality was unchanged with an even mix of heavy weight cows carrying good condition and plain condition cows. The beef cows carrying good condition were firm while the leaner 1 and 2 score grades of beef and dairy cows were 2c to 4c/kg easier. The C3 heavy weight bulls were a few cents dearer while the light weights were a few cents cheaper.

A small number of dairy cows sold from 93c to 124c/kg. Plain condition 1 and 2 score beef cows made between 91c and 127c/kg. Good condition 3 and 4 score heavy weight beef cows made from 125c to 140c/kg. Restocking cows returning to the paddock sold between 91c and 118c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold from 138c to 154c after a top of 170c/kg for a very good Euro bred bull.
