## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Numbers remained similar to the previous prime sale. Cattle were drawn from a wide area with good numbers from south-west and central-west regions of the State. The yarding quality was fair to good. The better end of grown steers and bullocks could not reach the previous sales high prices and overall averages declined 5c/kg. Meanwhile, heavy grown heifers found plenty of export buyer competition and jumped 8c/kg, while the plainer lines of lighter weight grown heifers reduced price averages by 9c/kg. The good quality cows held firm in price to 2c/kg dearer, but prices fell in the other classes. Good numbers of bulls were yarded and prices dropped 5c/kg.

Medium weight grown steers topped at 185c/kg and averaged 176c, down 5c/kg, while bullocks hit 183c and averaged 180c, down 5c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers sold to 168c and averaged 147c, down 9c/kg, while heavy weight grown heifers earned to 161c and averaged 159c, up 8c/kg.

Medium weight 2 score cows reached 127c and averaged 113c, down 9c/kg, while the 3 score lines topped at 146c and averaged 134c, unchanged in price. Medium weight 4 score cows made to 147c and averaged 144c, down 3c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows made to 155c and averaged 146c, up 2c/kg. Heavy bulls averaged 158c/kg.
