Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Market information provided by MLA's National Livestock Reporting Service

The final sale for 2012 saw numbers fall sharply. Quality also reduced slightly with a larger percentage of plainer cattle offered along with a few well finished pens. Yearlings again made up the majority offered with a smaller yarding of grown cattle. Not all the usual buyers were present and competing in a market that varied depending on quality.

Yearling steers to feed eased 2c to 3c/kg. Medium weights sold from 165c to 189c and heavy weights received 169c to 184c/kg. Those to processors were steady selling from 167c to 188c/kg. The heifer portion to feed also held fairly steady selling from 130c to 157c/kg for medium and heavy weights. Those to slaughter lifted 2c ranging from 140c to 170c/kg. Heavy steers and bullocks were limited in number and sold from 160c to 175c/kg. Cows were 5c to 7c cheaper with heavy 2 scores from 100c to 125c and 3 score from 124c to 130c/kg.
