

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Yarding numbers were similar to the previous week. A full panel of processor buyers were present and operating at the sale. Prices improved 3c to 6c for grown steers and bullocks, while medium weight grown heifers added 15c/kg and heavy weight grades held firm in price. Heavy weight 4 score cows jumped 4c, while large numbers of heavy bulls were yarded and prices were firm to 1c/kg cheaper in places.

Medium weight grown steers reached 163c, up 3c, while bullocks sold to 161c, up 6c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers reached 153c and averaged 146c, up 15c, while heavy weight grown heifers topped at 140c and averaged 131c/kg, unchanged in price.

Medium weight 3 score cows reached 113c and averaged 107c, up 4c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows earned to 115c and averaged 106c, up 1c, while heavy weight 4 score cows reached 127c and averaged 122c, up 4c/kg. Heavy bulls made to 154c and averaged 141c, down 1c/kg.
