

## Detailed saleyard report - cattle

Numbers increased 20% on the previous week. Processors displayed good demand across all categories of cattle with medium weight grown steers and bullocks adding 3c to 7c/kg. Grown heifers experienced increased demand from southern processors and jumped 3c to 9c/kg. Large numbers of good 4 score cows were penned this week and prices jumped 5c, while good bulls added 15c/kg.

Medium weight grown steers sold to 166c, up 3c, while good bullocks hit 171c and averaged 170c, up 7c and plainer D muscled lines averaged 160c, up 5c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers sold to 146c and averaged 143c, up 3c, while heavy weight grown heifers reached 163c and averaged 152c, up 9c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows made to 107c and averaged 101c, up 21c, while 3 score medium weights averaged 113c and heavy weights 120c/kg. Medium weight 4 score cows topped at 133c and averaged 127c, up 5c/kg. The heavy weight 4 score cows reached 139c and averaged 132c, up 5c/kg. Heavy weight bulls averaged 155c/kg.
