Yarding numbers jumped 35% after the previous week's increased demand from processor buyers. The good quality bullocks continued to sell well, but overall the yarding did not contain as many quality bullocks as the previous prime sale, with prices dropping 3c/kg. Grown heifers attracted both Queensland and southern processor competition, and prices remained firm to 3c/kg dearer on average. Cows could not maintain the recent price rises and declined 2c to 6c/kg on average. Only limited numbers of heavy bulls were yarded.

Good quality medium weight grown steers averaged 168c, up 3c, while bullocks hit 172c and also averaged 168c, down 3c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers reached 155c and averaged 146c, up 3c/kg. Heavy weight grown heifers topped at 154c and averaged 152c/kg, unchanged in price. Medium weight 2 score cows sold to 95c and averaged 81c, down 20c, while the 3 scores made to 119c and averaged 112c, down 2c/kg. The medium weight 4 score cows earned up to 133c and averaged 125c, down 2c/kg. The heavy weight 3 score cows topped at 118c and averaged 115c, down 6c, while heavy weight 4 score cows hit 135c and averaged 127c, down 5c/kg. Heavy bulls reached 159c and averaged 145c, down 11c/kg.
