There were approximately 400 grown and 740 young cattle penned. The usual buying group attended a generally firm market, cheaper in places. The vealers were very mixed but sold to generally firm demand, with a small lift in feeder purchases although activity was still subdued. There were fewer supplementary fed yearlings offered with the medium weight steers slipping 7c/kg on a plainer offering, while the heavy weights held firm along with the heifer portion. A limited selection of well-bred grown steers and bullocks sold generally firm, while the crossbred manufacturing steers eased slightly.

The best C3 vealer steers to the trade sold from 220c to 226c, lifting 2c, with the secondary lines from 175c to 210c/kg. The best C3 vealer heifers to the trade made between 204c to 220c holding firm, with the secondary lines between 164c and 212c/kg. Yearling trade steers sold between 192c and 222c/kg. Most yearling grass heifers made from 162c to 215c/kg.

Grown steers sold from 175c to 195c, slipping 1c/kg on most. Bullocks made between 178c and 190c, lifting 2c/kg on most. Crossbred manufacturing steers sold between 164c and 185c, while a selection of light weight Friesian steers sold between 150c and 156c/kg.
