Detailed saleyard report - cattle

The supply of stock experienced a large decline and most were drawn from the local area, plus a few from northern and western districts. Buyer representation was good and all were operating. The reduced supply of lesser quality heavy steers and bullocks varied in price. However a good quality lineup of grown heifers and cows lifted in price by 2c to 9c/kg and more on light weight plain condition lines.

Heavy steers in plain condition generally sold in the mid 140c range, while the better quality lines made to 163.2c to average 155c/kg. A few full mouth bullocks averaged from 137c to 142c/kg.

Lightweight plain condition cows to processors sold to 101.2c/kg. Medium weights averaged 100c and sold to 106.2c, with one consignment returning to the paddock at 105c/kg. Heavy 3 scores made from 110c to 117.2c/kg. Good heavy cows were well supplied and most sold close to 125c, with sales to 131.2c/kg. Heavy bulls experienced keen competition and made to 166.2c to average 145c/kg.
