Only lower numbers of prime cattle continued to come forward. A full panel of local and southern export buyers were present and competition was strong between processors. Grown steers and bullocks were in fair to good condition and prices were solid for all classes. Grown heifers hit 160c/kg for crop fed sorts and southern processors were keen to secure extra supply. Heavy cows also experienced a dearer price trend.

Medium weight grown steers topped at 174c/kg and averaged 171c, while slightly plainer sorts averaged 166c/kg. Bullocks hit 177c and averaged 172c, while plainer lines averaged 162c/kg. Medium weight grown heifers reached 160c and averaged 154c and heavy weight grown heifers topped at 158c and averaged 152c/kg.

Medium weight 2 score cows made to 107c and averaged 91c, while medium weight 3 score cows earned to 118c and averaged 112c/kg. Heavy weight 4 score cows reached 138c and most averaged between 127c and 130c/kg. Heavy bulls topped at 168c and averaged 147c/kg.
