

## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

There were approximately 190 cows and 15 bulls penned. The usual buying group was present, but operating very selectively in a cheaper market. Most weights and grades were represented and demand eased considerably across all categories. Restockers were operating on a limited number of suitable light weight cows and purchased them for around 17c/kg cheaper week-on-week. Cows to processors eased 12c to 21c, while heavy weight bulls lost 18c to 23c/kg.

A handful of dairy cows sold from 97c to 123c, falling 13c to 20c/kg. Light weight beef cows made from 86c to 132c, back 14c to 21c/kg. Heavy weight beef cows sold between 100c and 145c, falling 12c to 21c/kg. Restocking cows made from 97c to 126c, falling 17c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold from 130c to 155c, back 18c to 23c/kg.
