Prices from most contributors remained unchanged this week, yet rates were reduced in the south with reports of plenty supply. Reports suggest that quality in parts of the south has lifted with spring cattle coming forward, while further north, good cattle numbers are reportedly coming through from parts of western Queensland.

For the physical markets, prices were back across the majority of categories, easing up to 11¢/kg in places.
