Prices from the majority of contributors were slightly dearer this week, as reports suggest some of the recent rain to have tightened supplies, coupled with some increased demand in places.

The physical markets also saw dearer prices across the eastern states, averaging around 5¢/kg lwt higher for yearling steers and heifers week-on-week.
