## **Detailed saleyard report - cattle**

Good numbers of store cattle were penned for the first sale of the year. Feedlot buyers displayed solid demand for suitable medium and heavy weight yearling steers, however restocker buyers were in limited attendance. The majority of the cattle were drawn from parts of south west Queensland, with a few consignment from central west regions. Overall, quality was mixed with good quality medium and heavy weight steers and heifers firm in price, however plainer light weight steers met subdued competition. Feedlot buyers were more active on light weight yearling heifers. The large supply of store conditioned cows yarded resulted in most selling for less than 98c/kg. Cows and calves sold to \$430/unit.

Light weight yearling steers reached 190c and averaged 173c, while plainer lines averaged 156c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed topped at 195c and averaged 173c and those returning to the paddock hit 190c and averaged 180c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed earned to 195c/kg and averaged 180c, while D muscled sorts averaged 165c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to feed made to 148c and averaged 137c, while those bought by restockers sold to 154c and averaged 121c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed made to 151c and averaged 145c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed made to 151c and averaged 145c/kg.

A few grown steers to feed averaged between 148c and 158c/kg. Light and medium weight 2 score cows earned to 98c and averaged between 56c and 82c, depending on quality and condition, while some returned to the paddock between 69c and 88c/kg. A small sample of medium weight 4 score cows sold to 147c/kg.
