### Eastern States

report date 17 Jan 2014

Feeder rates across the eastern states varied throughout domestic and export categories, as reports suggest sufficient numbers are still available in the market.

Across the physical markets, rates were generally lower, with trade C2 yearling steers on 163¢, back 6¢ week-on-week, while grown steers averaged 13¢ lower on 158¢/kg lwt.
