There were approximately 165 cows and 30 bulls penned, representing a reduction of around 80 head week-on-week. Most of the usual buying group was present, although not all operated in what was a slightly cheaper market in most places. Most weights and grades were represented in the cows and restockers were operating at dearer prices on the suitable lines, while the balance of the light and medium weight lines were mostly in poor condition and eased by up to 8c/kg. Heavy weight cows eased between 1c and 4c/kg, with the poor condition E1 cows slipping the most as they missed the competition from the absent processor. Heavy weight bulls sold firm for the C muscle lines and eased 4c/kg for the better yielding B muscle animals.

Light and medium weight cows to processors sold from 88c to 114c, slipping 3c to 8c/kg. Heavy weight cows made between 108c and 128c, easing 1c to 4c/kg. Restocking cows sold between 104c and 119c, lifting 4c to 7c/kg. Heavy weight bulls to processors made from 118c to 138c after reaching 144c/kg for a good European bred bull.
