There were approximately 360 cows and 40 bulls penned, representing an increase of 35 head week-on-week. The usual buying group was present and competing in a dearer market. Quality was good, with a larger proportion of well finished heavy weights with good yield potential and all exporters were keen to secure numbers. Most weights and grades were represented, with cow prices from 6c to 14c dearer, while the heavy weight bulls improved 20c/kg.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 140c to 165c/kg. Heavy weight cows made mostly between 160c and 186c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold between 170c and 207c/kg.
