There were approximately 190 cattle penned representing a decrease of 130 head week-on-week. The usual buying group was present and competing in a dearer market. Quality was mixed in the limited selection however there were a good proportion of heavy weight cows showing good finish. Prices improved 10c to 12c/kg with a few young cows selling dearer, while the heavy weight bulls held firm.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 130c to 155c/kg. Heavy weight cows made mostly between 150c and 177c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold between 177c and 200c/kg.
