There were approximately 330 cows and 20 bulls penned for a similar overall number to the sale of a fortnight ago. There was a smaller group of buyers operating in a firm cow market, dearer for the bulls. With two regular export processors absent from the gallery there were only three operating, leading to flat competition. Most weights and grades were represented in the cows, with a larger offering of plain light weight dairy cows, however prices remained within 2c/kg either side of equal to last sale. A better quality run of heavy weight bulls sold 6c to 10c/kg dearer.

Most light and medium weight cows sold from 105c to 140c/kg. Heavy weight cows made between 135c and 158c/kg. Heavy weight bulls sold between 160c and 195c/kg.
