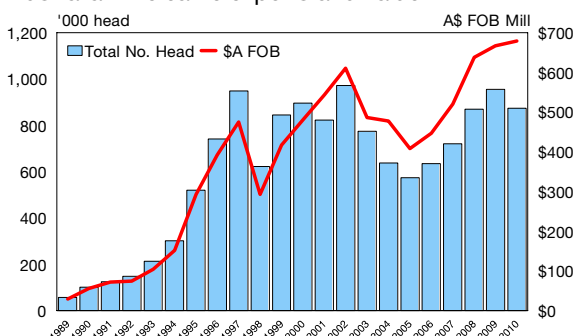
Live cattle exports

Quick Facts

- Australian live cattle exports totalled 873,573 head in 2010 down 8.5% on 2009, valued at A\$678 million.
- The largest market, Indonesia took 520,987 head, down 33% on 2009 and 60% of total exports, valued at A\$318 million.
- Shipments to the Middle East grew by 134% year-on-year to 226,547 head, worth A\$172 million.
- Western Australia, the largest export state for cattle shipped 369,961 head, valued at A\$252 million.
- The Northern Territory, the second largest state shipped 292,305 head, valued at A\$183 million.
- Total dairy cattle exports increased 20% on 2009, with 78,702 head exported, valued at A\$145 million.

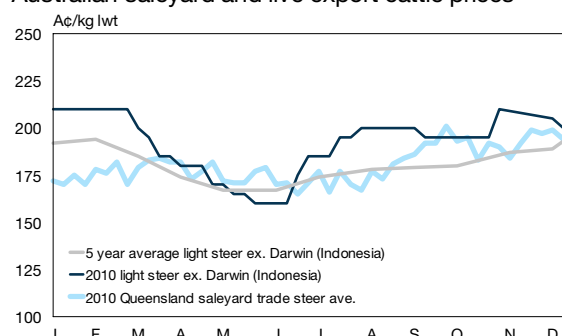
Australian live cattle exports and value

Australian live cattle exports by key markets

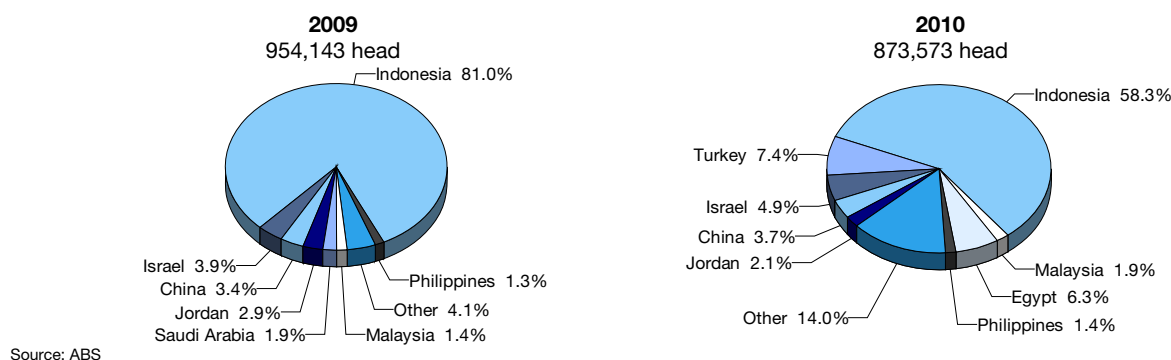

Australian live cattle exports to Indonesia

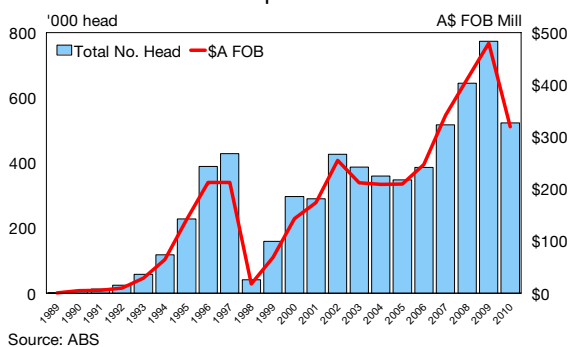

Australian live dairy cattle by key destination

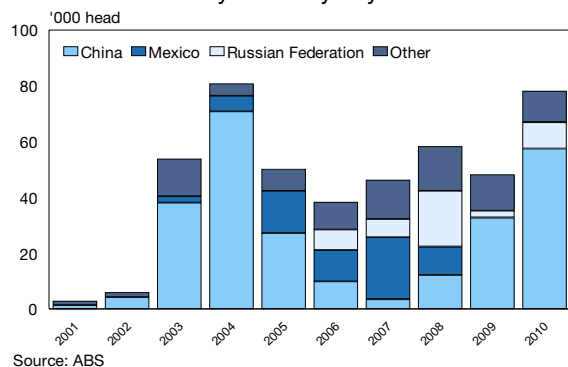

Australian live cattle exports key regions

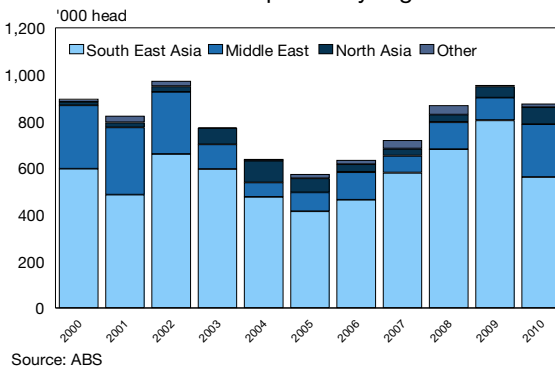

Australian live cattle exports to Middle East

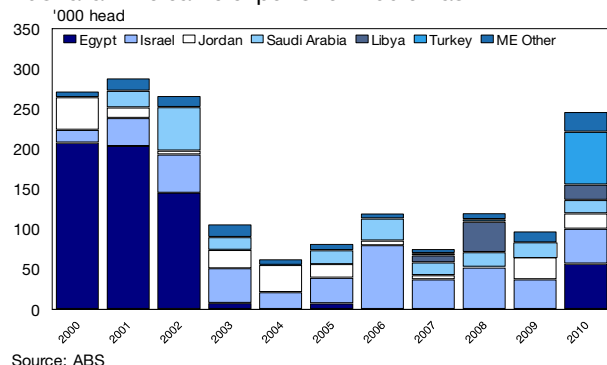

Australian live cattle exports to South East Asia

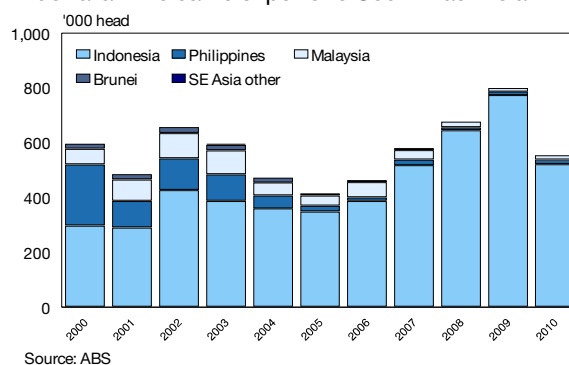

Australian live cattle export by state

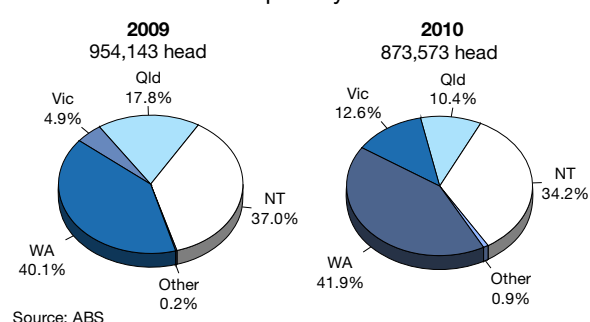

Australia live cattle exports by load port

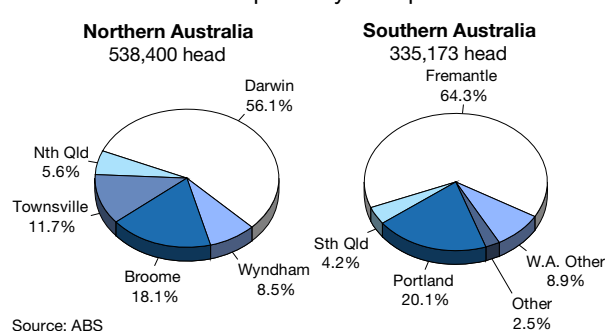

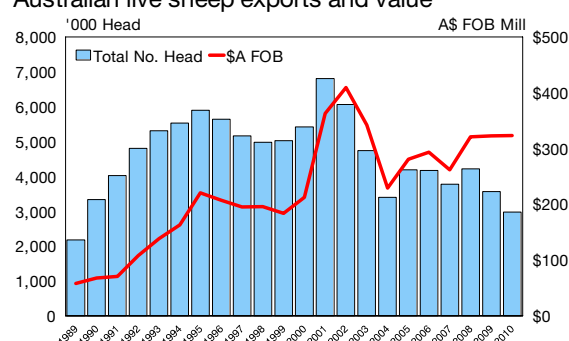

- Australian live sheep exports totalled 2,978,154 head in 2010 down 17% on 2009, valued at A\$323 million.
- The Middle East, a major destination, took over 99% of Australian sheep exports.
- The largest market, Kuwait took 1,076,455 head up 14% on 2009, and 36% of total exports, valued at A\$122 million.
- Western Australia, the largest export state for sheep, shipped 2,419,252 head, valued at A\$262 million.
- Victoria, the second largest export state shipped 438,178 head, valued at A\$46 million.

Australian live sheep exports by load port

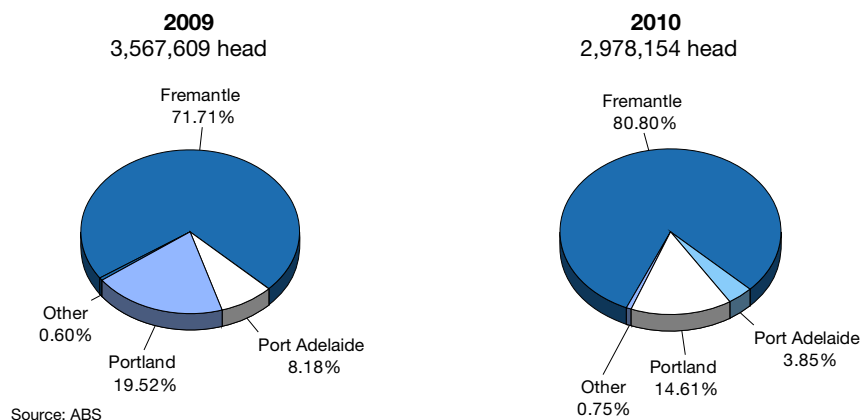

Australian live sheep exports to Kuwait

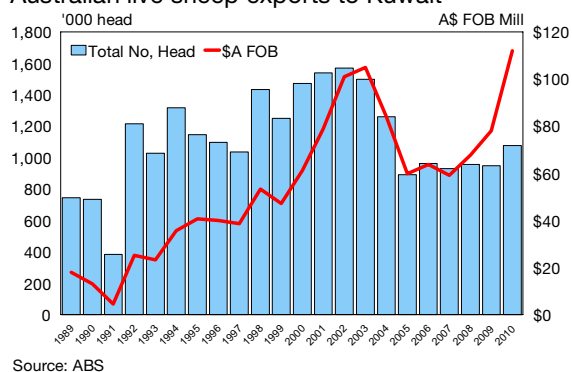

Australian live sheep exports to Middle East

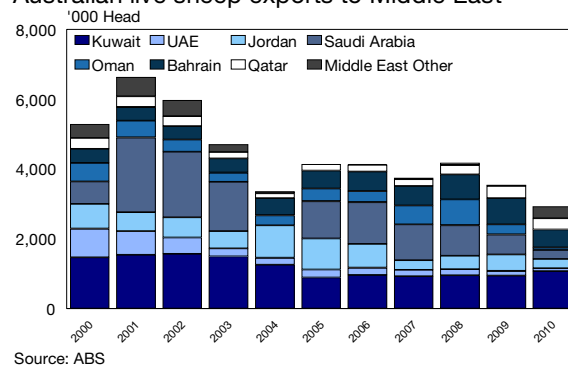

Australian Live Sheep Export By State

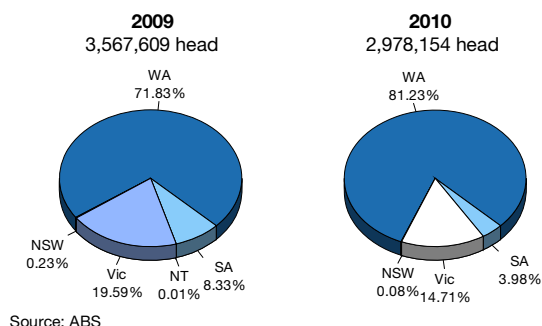

Australian live sheep exports by load port

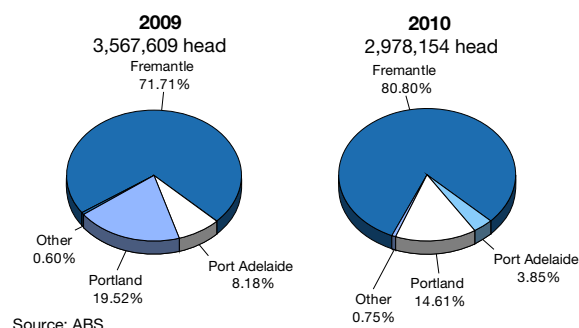

- The largest market, Malaysia took 67,675 head, 84% of total exports, down 24% on 2009.
- South Australia, the largest export state for goats shipped 23,147 head, valued at A\$8 million.
- In 2010, 98% or 79,040 head of goats were exported via air freight.

Australian live goat exports and value

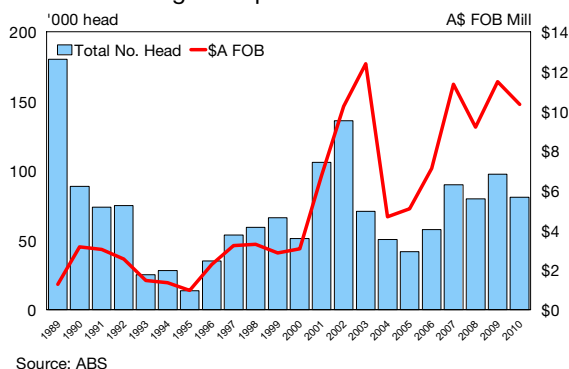

Australian live goat exports key regions

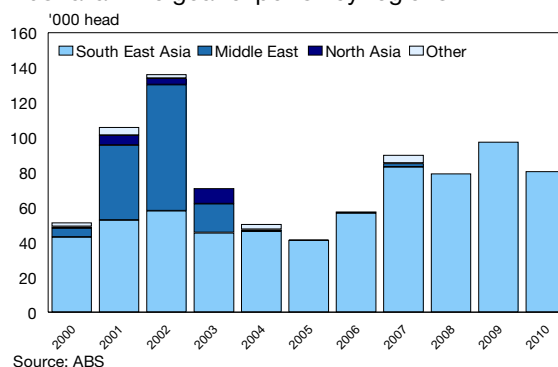

Australian live goat export by key markets

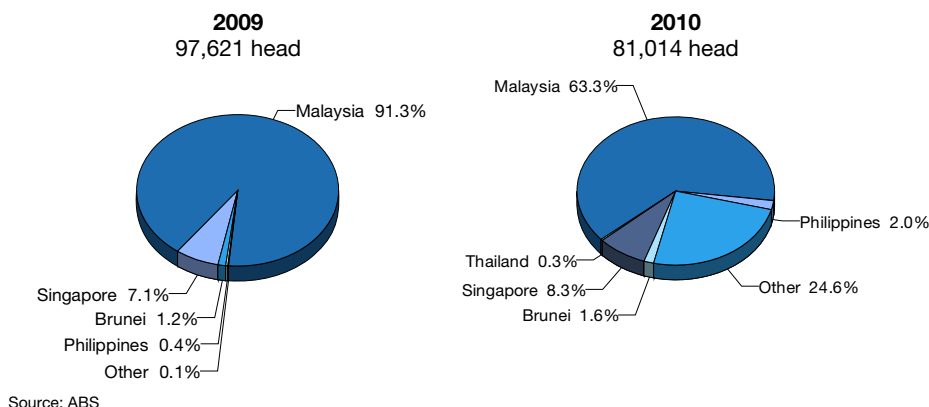

Australian live goat exports to Malaysia

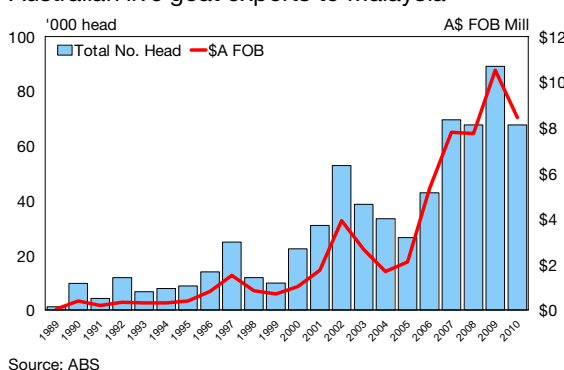

Australian live goat exports south east Asia

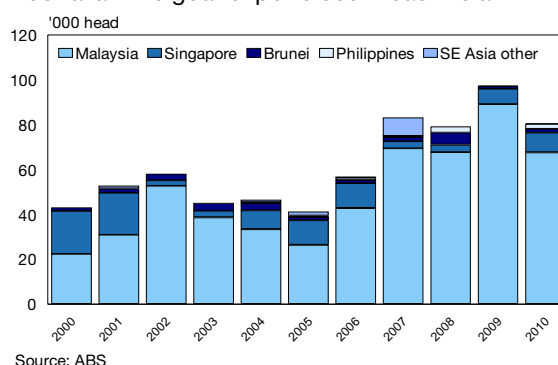

Australian Live Goat Export By State

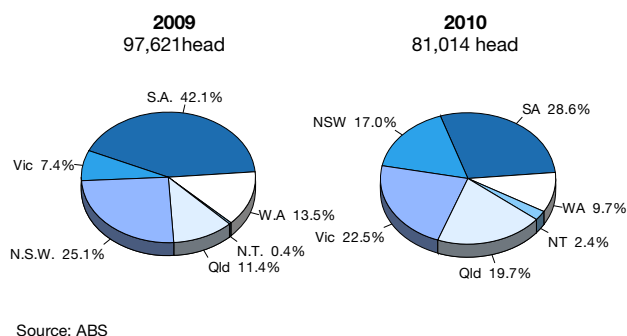

Australian live goat export by load port

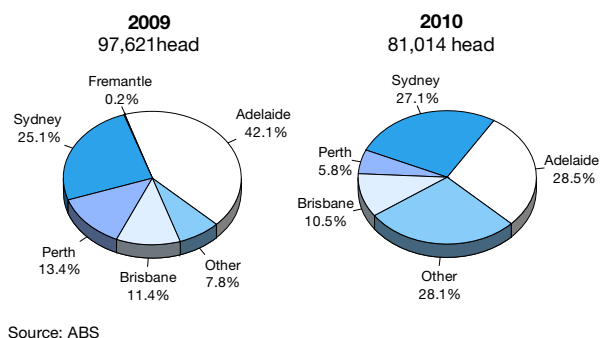
