A number of processors adjusted rates for the third consecutive week, which resulted in all categories recoding a cheaper trend. The high A\$ combined with increasing supplies have been the main factors driving the market, as most grades fell by at least 10¢/kg cwt. Additionally, processors have a good amount of cattle directly consigned in the coming weeks.
